


An International Community for Breed and Seed Savers

To make sure that Variety-Savers.Net is really only for those interested in conservation work, your registration will only be approved once it has been checked by a moderator (usually during office hours). You will be informed of your approval by email. With a password of your choice you can access and change your profile at any time.

Using the “Google translate” tool you can choose your language so that you can understand and reply to colleagues in other countries. This makes the network usable across language barriers. If you are searching for a particular breed or variety however, this should be searched for using its original name, not a translation, in order to optimise the search.
